

About the Canada Community and Culture Fund

The COVID crisis has had a devastating impact on this city of Jerusalem and its people. Residents are slowly learning to live with Covid and find ways to adjust to uncertainty and a very changed world. Rapidly evolving restrictions and rates of infection have forced to be innovative and creative as we look towards a different future than we had expected. Jerusalem has one of the highest rates of infection amongst cities in Israel. One of the characteristics of the city, due to the city's population, is a significantly higher percentage of families with children (and sometimes many children) with verified COVID19 infections. This impact however will continue to be felt in the years to come.

Canadians have a long history of providing support to the vulnerable in Jerusalem and to arts organizations and institutions in the city. In response to the COVID-19 crisis, the Jerusalem Foundation of Canada has launched the The Canada Community and

Culture Fund. This new fund will support two critical areas for the wellbeing of Jerusalem: ongoing needs for vulnerable residents of Jerusalem of all ages and the recovery of the cultural sector which has been decimated by COVID. Working in close cooperation with Mayor Moshe Lion and his team, funds raised will maximize the efficient and effective delivery of essential goods and services to residents of the city.

In response to the current health, social and economic crisis, the Jerusalem Foundation will continue to provide support and a safetynet to the most vulnerable residents from all population groups in the city. This support includes provision of food, respite, mental health support and outreach to those across this city who have required it. In addition, The Jerusalem Foundation will continue to advance the adaptation and recovery of the cultural and creative life of Jerusalem during this crisis.











Location of the Canada Pathway

This central location in Jerusalem is a focal point of the Cultural Quarter, the Musrara/Morasha neighborhood is adjacent to the Old City and on the seam of east and west, near Safra Square City Hall (1), the new campus of the Bezalel Academy of Art (2) and is the beating heart of Jerusalem. The path is framed by Canada House (3) and the Inukshuk sculpture (4), the Ma'aleh Film School (5), the Naggar Musrara School of Art and Society (6) and takes us on a journey through one of the first neighborhoods of modern Jerusalem.
